- Gala, Golden Delicious, Granny Smith, Elstar
- 50% Malus Golden Gem + 50% Malus INRA® Baugene®

POLLINATOR FOR: Gala, Golden Delicious, Elstar

**TREE TYPE:** type III (Golden Delicious)

GROWTH: Strong (choose M9 Pajam®1 Lancep, M9T337 or M9 NAKB)

## **PRODUCTIVITY:**

- Time till first cropping: rapid
- Yields: good
- Susceptibility to alternate bearing: as for Fuji
- Thinning: rather difficult



# SUSCEPTIBILITY / RESISTANCE TO **DISEASES:**

- Average susceptibility to scab
- Low susceptibility to mildew and fire blight

## **FRUIT:**

- Skin: the most coloured of the early Fuji sports
- Flesh: crisp, juicy and fine
- Taste: very sweet if the crop load is not too heavy. One of the sweetest early sports of Fuji

## **STORAGE:**

- Cold storage : February
- CA storage : March

## USES:

- Early sales of Fuji
- The standard maturity Fuji types have a better colour and storage potential
