## THE FRUIT

**PICKING DATE:** as Braeburn

**FRUIT / FLESH:**

- Bicoloured fruit with 80% colour in areas that colour well.
- Tangy flavour at harvest, which softens after storage to give a balanced, aromatic, crunchy and juicy taste. One of the best in the tastings after storage.

**STORAGE POTENTIAL:** the potential of this variety is yet to be determined, but it looks promising in all the trials carried out.
